

## CARE & USE INSTRUCTIONS

### CARE & USE OF YOUR HAND MADE CONCRETE LANE PRODUCT

Thanks for choosing a handmade product from Concrete Lane. We want to make sure that you will enjoy your new basin for years to come so please follow this care and use guide.

\* DO NOT use any abrasive cleaning products that you will find typically in your cupboard or on the supermarket shelf like, but not limited to, Windex, Jiff and spray n wipe.

\* Clean the basin or benchtop with a microfibre cloth.

\* Clean up your spills as they happen and use a wet cloth for dried spills. For stubborn stains a non-abrasive cleanser such as Cerapol from Selleys. Avoid forceful scrubbing as this may result in loss of shine and remove the protective sealer.

\* Concrete expands when it is exposed to heat, place a trivet or mat down before you place your hot items, or for plates, bowls, cups, vases any hard surface to avoid scratches on your benchtop.

\* Your new basin or benchtop come with a protective wax sealer which should be applied to the surface of the product at least every 12 months. Just like oiling a timber or sealing a marble top, it will bring back the lustre in the concrete surface. Using a slightly damp microfibre cloth wipe wax sealer onto the surface, applying in a circular hand motion overlapping to ensure no missed spots. Leave for a few minutes and buff off with a clean dry microfibre cloth.

#### **\*\*PLUMBERS PLEASE NOTE\*\***

Installation of the waste MUST include rubber seals on TOP and BOTTOM of the basin. If these are not included it will void all warranty on the basin.

### **THIS BASIN MUST BE INSTALLED BY A LICENSED PLUMBER IN ACCORDANCE WITH LOCAL REGULATIONS**

Remove product from packaging:

Check the product for damage, if the product is damaged return to store of purchase. Check the product is complete with all components required to install. This product is to only be installed by a licensed plumber, failing to do so will void warranty. This product is to be installed as per Australian Standard and local authority requirements.

### BASIN INSTALLATION

1. Determine where on the bench top the basin is to be installed.
2. Place the basin in position and check to ensure the basin waste outlet position does not interfere with drawers, internal walls or waste connection pipe work.
3. Fit waste to basin as per waste instructions and ensure TOP and BOTTOM seals are installed.
4. Run a bead of plumbers grade silicone around the underside edge of the basin.
5. Fit basin to bench top, allow silicone to set before proceeding with waste pipe installation.

### CONCRETE SLABS AND BENCHTOPS

All concrete slabs and benchtops must be handled and installed by a qualified tradesperson such as cabinet maker, stonemason, builder or carpenter. We recommend that all trades working with concrete slabs and benchtops always adhere to safe work practices and abide by all the building codes and regulations. In order to prevent any accidents, we strongly recommend that all trades handling this material follow these simple safety procedures:

Concrete slabs and benchtops should be carried by at least two people or proper lifting devices. When handling this product, we recommend that industrial protective gloves (AS/NZS 2161) eye wear, earmuffs and appropriate rubber soled footwear are used.

Slabs or benchtops must be installed on a very sound and solid frame or a base which is perfectly flat and true.

All the cut outs should be cut using only wet cutting tools to avoid generating excess dust and heat to the tops and the corners.

Apply dabs of flexible glue (silicon) at a regular intervals of not less than 25 cm apart on the back of the top then place the tops gently and level the tops before the glue (silicon) cures.
